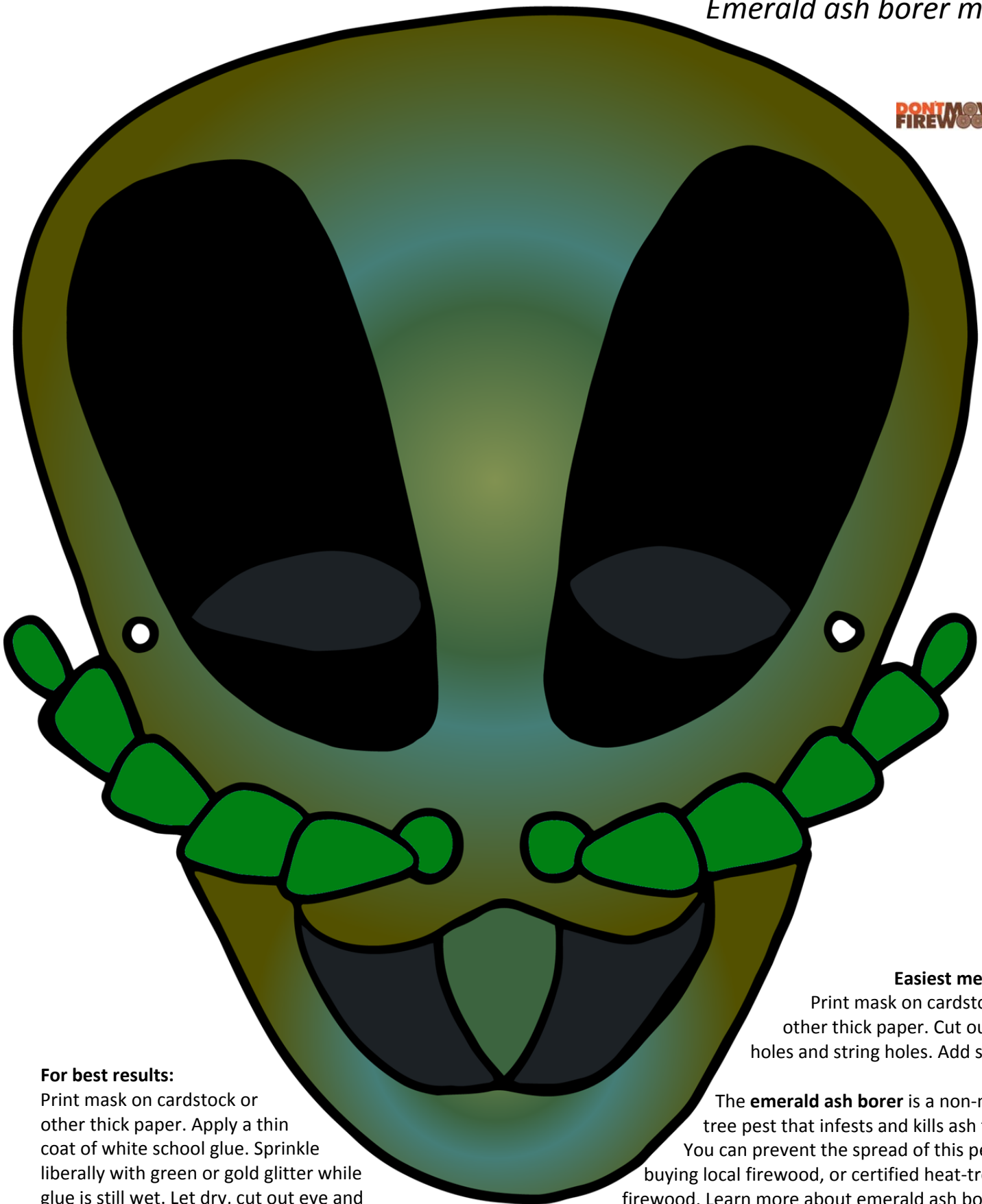


Emerald ash borer mask

For best results:

Print mask on cardstock or other thick paper. Apply a thin coat of white school glue. Sprinkle liberally with green or gold glitter while glue is still wet. Let dry, cut out eye and string holes. Add string!

Easiest method:

Print mask on cardstock or other thick paper. Cut out eye holes and string holes. Add string!
