**38%** of people are aware that invasive insects can move in firewood. With consistent outreach, that number jumps to **96%**.



4.27 MILLION GALLONS OF MAPLE SYRUP were produced in the U.S. in 2017; 19 MILLION GALLONS were produced in Canada in 2016.

North America's maple trees are threatened by the **ASIAN LONGHORNED BEETLE**, a forest pest currently being eradicated in three states.

**THERE ARE 20% MORE TREES** in the U.S. today than in 1970, when the first Earth Day was celebrated.

**950,000** people work in the U.S. and Canadian forest products industry.

A single tree can absorb more than **10 pounds of CO<sub>2</sub>** each year.
