North America's maple trees are threatened by the ASIAN LONGHORNED BEETLE, a forest pest currently being eradicated in three states.

THERE ARE 20% MORE TREES in the U.S. today than in 1970, when the first Earth Day was celebrated.

950,000 people work in the U.S. and Canadian forest products industry.

A single tree can absorb more than 10 pounds of CO₂ each year.
