

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In September 2008, Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA) conducted a questionnaire survey for state park visitors on the North Shore. The same survey had been implemented in the same fashion at the same parks in 2005. The results indicate that some progress has been made in raising awareness of emerald ash borer, as well as the risks posed by firewood movement.

Emerald ash borer (EAB) has now been found as close to Minnesota as eastern Wisconsin. With firewood identified as the primary means of spreading EAB, raising awareness about both is a critical component in delaying the introduction into and spread throughout Minnesota of this devastating forest pest.

The survey was completed by 375 state park visitors. When asked about EAB, 2008 survey respondents showed a 40% increase in awareness over 2005 survey respondents. There was also a 23% decrease from 2005 to 2008 in the number of people who said they brought wood from home when they go camping.

INTRODUCTION AND OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this study were to gauge the level of invasive species awareness and the recreation and media habits of visitors to state parks along the north shore of Minnesota. Understanding public knowledge and behavior regarding invasive species is important in implementing effective public outreach to prevent the spread of invasive species – many of which are spread primarily through human activity.

A number of invasive forest pests are of particular concern for Minnesota, including emerald ash borer, gypsy moth, *Sirex* woodwasp and Asian longhorned beetle. None of these pests are considered established in Minnesota as of 2008, and every year they can be prevented from reaching Minnesota provides economic and environmental benefits to the state.

In addition to being forest pests, these species share another trait: they are easily moved by recreationalists. Emerald ash borer, *Sirex* woodwasp and Asian longhorned beetle are wood-boring insects and can easily be moved in firewood. Emerald ash borer in particular has drawn a lot of attention to the potential for firewood movement to enable the rapid spread of an invasive species. While gypsy moth does not travel inside wood like the other species, their egg masses may be laid and then moved on firewood or on any other outdoor item such as a camper, boat, or even lawn furniture.

In addition to assessing public awareness and behavior in 2008, a comparison can also be made to public awareness and behavior in 2005 when an identical study was performed. Results from the study in 2005 were used to help design outreach programs implemented from 2005 – 2008.

METHODOLOGY

The questionnaire survey was conducted on Saturday, September 13, 2008 at eight state parks along the North Shore (from north to south): Grand Portage, Judge C.R. Magney, Cascade River, Temperance River, George H. Crosby Manitou, Tettegouche, Split Rock and Gooseberry Falls. Staff from the Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA), Invasive Species Exclusion Unit and the Gypsy Moth Unit, performed the survey from approximately 11 AM – 5 PM. The 2005 questionnaire survey was performed in the same parks on a similar date (September 17, 2005).

The survey staff solicited park visitors to complete the survey through a variety of methods including visiting campsites, standing at high visitor use areas like scenic overlooks and leaving questionnaires on the windshields of parked vehicles. Visitors were given the option of completing the survey in person, completing the survey later and leaving in a park drop box or mailing the survey to MDA later. Most surveys were completed in person, but some were also received after the fact.



The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) provided access to the parks and use of the park drop boxes. The DNR also provided space to set up signage and a table to advertise the survey, though in most parks this was not done as it was more efficient to go to the potential survey subjects rather than to wait for them to come to us.

The questionnaires were pre-labeled with a number representing the park where they would be used as well as a number identifying the individual questionnaire. The number of questionnaires distributed was tracked so as to determine the response rate. An example questionnaire can be seen in Appendix A.

Survey results were tabulated and compared to the 2005 results due to the similarity in the design and implementation of the survey between the two years.

RESULTS

The 2008 questionnaire was completed by 375 people, the majority of these questionnaires were completed at the time of the survey. A total of 430 surveys were distributed, the completion rate was about 87%. In 2005 the questionnaire was completed by 309 people. The results from the 2008 survey are presented in comparison with results from the 2005 survey. See Appendix A for example questionnaire used in both the 2008 and 2005 survey. See Appendix B for complete survey data set.



Question 1: Including this visit, how often did you go camping or visit parks / recreational / natural areas in Minnesota this year? (Check one)

Results: Survey responses were nearly identical between 2005 and 2008. No significant difference was found among responses between survey years (Chi Square = 4.27, d.f.=5, p value = 0.51).



Question 2: How often did you go camping or visit parks / recreational / natural areas outside of Minnesota this year? (Check one)

Results: As in question 1, survey responses were very similar between 2008 and 2005. Responses were weighted slightly towards more frequent visits outside Minnesota during 2008, but the difference was minimal (Chi Square = 6.02, d.f. = 3, p value = 0.11 – because of small counts in the higher categories, the categories “11 – 15”, “16 – 20”, and “> 20” were pooled into a single category: “> 10” for the Chi Square test).



Question 3: Which of the following insects, plants or animals have you heard of? (Check all that apply)

Results: Among aquatic pests, awareness appeared to trend downwards from 2005 to 2008. The percent of people aware of zebra mussels (ZM), Eurasian watermilfoil (EWM), Asian carp (AC) and purple loosestrife (PL) measured lower in 2008 than in 2005 – however, none of these differences were statistically significant. Awareness of terrestrial species such as buckthorn (BT), emerald ash borer (EAB) and garlic mustard (GAM) measured statistically higher in 2008 than 2005.

The biggest jump was seen for emerald ash borer for which awareness increased 40%




from 2005 to 2008. Awareness of gypsy moth (GYM) was consistently high in both years, while the awareness of Asian longhorn beetle (ALB) measured lower but was not statistically different between the two years. Responses to the imaginary “Rhodesian banner thistle” (RBT) measured about the same each year. This pseudonym was included as a check on the accuracy of respondent knowledge vs. response.

Question 4: Which of the above insects, plants or animals is most familiar to you? (Choose one)

Results: Four responses in 2008 indicated “All” – these were removed from the analysis. Fifty-one responses in 2008 indicated more than one species was most familiar, in these cases the first species listed was considered to be what the responder meant as the most familiar and these responses were included in the analysis.

Similar to Question 4, responses for aquatic pests (Eurasian watermilfoil, zebra mussel, purple loosestrife and Asian carp) measured lower in 2008 than in 2005, but were not statistically different between the two years for all but purple




loosestrife. Response for terrestrial species again tended to be higher, with statistical increases seen for emerald ash borer and garlic mustard but a statistical decrease seen for Asian longhorned beetle.

Question 5: When you visit parks / recreational / natural areas or go camping, where do you typically get your firewood? (Check all that apply)


Results: People were significantly less likely to respond that they brought firewood from home in 2008 than in 2005. Responses to obtaining wood at a park were measured higher in 2008 than in 2005, but the difference was not statistically significant. Responses to obtaining wood from a store near a park or near home were very similar between 2005 and 2008.

Question 6: When you visit parks / recreational / natural areas or go camping, what equipment or supplies do you typically bring into these areas? (Check all that apply)

Results: Responses declined throughout all the categories from 2005 to 2008, however the most statistically relevant difference was seen in firewood. Lawn furniture, barbecue and camper / RV also measured lower from 2005 to 2008, but not to the degree seen with firewood.

Question 7: What are your favorite outdoor or sporting goods stores? (Name up to three)

Results: A total of 67 stores were reported by people taking the survey. Thirty-eight of those stores were reported once and including these a total of 56 were reported less than 10 times. The stores reported 10 or more times are listed here. 2008 results were similar to 2005 in that the top three stores from 2005 (REI, Gander Mountain, Cabela's) were also the top three in 2008 and were listed in the same order of popularity.

Question 8: To what outdoor or sporting magazines do you subscribe? (Name up to three)

Results: Approximately 95 different magazines were reported in the survey. Due to differences in how the names of those magazines were recorded it is difficult to calculate exactly how many were reported and how many times each was reported. Of those 95 different magazines, 91 were reported fewer than 10 times. The top five magazines recorded were Minnesota Conservation Volunteer (16), Backpacker (13), Outside Magazine (13), Outdoor Life (12) and Field and Stream (7). All of these magazines were also among the top magazines identified in 2005.

Question 9: Where do you typically get your news? (Name the top three: Please be as specific as possible and include names of media outlets)

Results: In 2008, the responses to this question were looked at in two ways. Broadly, the responses were grouped into categories by media type. The number of responses falling into each media type were tabulated. Some responses could not be labeled as belonging to a particular media type – for instance, many entities deliver news through more than one method, if the delivery method was not identified the answer could not be assigned to a category. No comparisons could be made to 2005, as delivery method was not recorded in the responses.

Much like Question 8, results from Question 9 are hard to summarize at a specific level because of the variation in how responses were given and recorded. For instance, “Channel 11” means one thing in one part of the state and another in a different part. Due to the difficulty in trying to infer the meaning from the responses, these specific results are not summarized here, but can be viewed in the complete data set in Appendix B.

Question 10: What is your Zip Code?

Results: In the 2008 survey, 298 respondents were from Minnesota, 60 were from the US outside of Minnesota, 8 were from Canada and 2 were from Vietnam. Nine surveys did not list any zip code and 8 surveys listed more than 1 zip code. Sixteen of respondents were from areas quarantined for EAB and 18 respondents were from areas quarantined for gypsy moth within the United States. No Canadian visitors originated from areas quarantined for gypsy moth or emerald ash borer.




Ad hoc comparisons:

The informal design of this study prohibits extrapolating any results beyond the subset of park visitors who completed the survey. However, comparisons can be made within the study group regarding recreational behavior, awareness of invasive species, media habits, etc.

Comparison 1: Frequency of visits within Minnesota vs. awareness of invasive species.

Results: Due to low counts in the higher visit categories, the categories “11 – 15”, “16 – 20”, and “> 20” were pooled into a single category: “> 10”. For

many pests, respondents who made more frequent visits to natural areas during the past year had a greater awareness of invasive pests. The only pests for which



some statistical difference was not seen were Asian longhorn beetle, garlic mustard and Rhodesian banner thistle (a pseudonym).



Comparison 2: Frequency of visits outside Minnesota vs. awareness of invasive species.

Results: Due to low counts in the higher visit categories, the categories “11 – 15”, “16 – 20”, and “> 20” were

pooled into a single category: “> 10”. While a difference was seen for higher visit frequency within Minnesota, the same difference was not seen for respondents with a higher frequency of visits outside of Minnesota. The only pests that some difference was seen in were purple loosestrife and


garlic mustard. However, no difference was seen for garlic mustard in comparison 1 (previous page).


Comparison 3: Frequency of visits in Minnesota vs firewood sources.

Results: More frequent visitors were more likely to say they got wood at the park then less frequent visitors. A difference was also seen in the number of people getting wood from a store near a park, though rather than an overall trend, there was a sharp decrease in the 6 - 10 category.



Comparison 4: Frequency of visits outside Minnesota vs. firewood sources.


Results: No differences were seen in this comparison.

Comparison 5: Primary media type for news vs awareness of invasive species.


Results: The first media type reported by respondents was compared to their awareness of invasive species. Some differences were seen for zebra mussel, gypsy moth, purple loosestrife, Asian longhorn beetle, emerald ash borer and garlic mustard. For most, radio was the most common media by which to receive news.

Comparison 6: Distance traveled this trip vs. typical firewood source.


Results: The distance from the respondent's home zip code to the park they were visiting was calculated and grouped into categories. Note that the distance traveled is specific to this trip, but the response to the questions were not. Some differences were seen in this comparison. Respondents who traveled farther for this trip, were generally less likely to get firewood from any source.

Comparison 7: Distance traveled this trip vs. items typically brought.


Results: People who traveled farther on this trip, were generally less likely to bring items along with them – particularly a tent, lawn furniture and a boat / canoe.

Comparison 8. Distance traveled this trip vs. awareness of invasive species.

Results: People who traveled farther for this trip tended to be less aware of most invasive species they were asked about. However, no difference was seen for Asian longhorn beetle, garlic mustard or Rhodesian banner thistle (pseudonym).

CONCLUSIONS

One of the most notable results of the survey was the increase in awareness of emerald ash borer (EAB) from 2005 to 2008. Among survey respondents, awareness of EAB increased 40% from 2005 to 2008 (Question 3). This is not surprising considering the increased attention EAB has received as it has been found closer to Minnesota and outreach activities have intensified in Minnesota and elsewhere. This increase in EAB awareness was also seen when respondents were asked which invasive species was most familiar to them (Question 4). Over 5% more respondents selected EAB as the most familiar species in 2008 than in 2005.

Another notable difference was a steep decline in the number of people who indicated that they typically brought wood from home when camping from 41% in 2005 to 18% in 2008 (Question 5). This difference is not surprising as a rule was implemented in 2007 that firewood brought into state parks must be from an approved vendor – not from a home supply. Since the survey was implemented in state parks it is possible that respondents did not answer truthfully because they feared there would be consequences. It is also possible that there has been some behavior change in response to public outreach campaigns regarding the risks posed by moving firewood.

The decrease in the percent of respondents who said they brought firewood from home was also seen in question 6 which asked what items were typically brought on trips. In 2005, 43% of respondents said they brought firewood and in 2008 only 18% said they did.

Some trends were also seen when comparing respondents answers to different questions in the 2008 survey (Comparisons 1 – 8). However, due to the informal design of this survey these trends should not be extrapolated beyond the study group taking the survey.

In 2008, respondents tended to be more aware of invasive species the more frequently they utilized Minnesota parks and natural areas. The more frequent visitors also were more likely to answer that they get their firewood at the park they are staying at. These trends were not seen when looking at respondent's frequency of visits to parks outside of Minnesota.

Respondents in the 2008 survey who traveled farther during the trip on which they were surveyed, also tended to be less likely to bring items with them when they typically go camping anywhere. This could be because they are more likely to take long distance trips than short distance trips.

The results of the survey indicate that some progress has been made among a portion of the population in terms of awareness of EAB and firewood issues.
