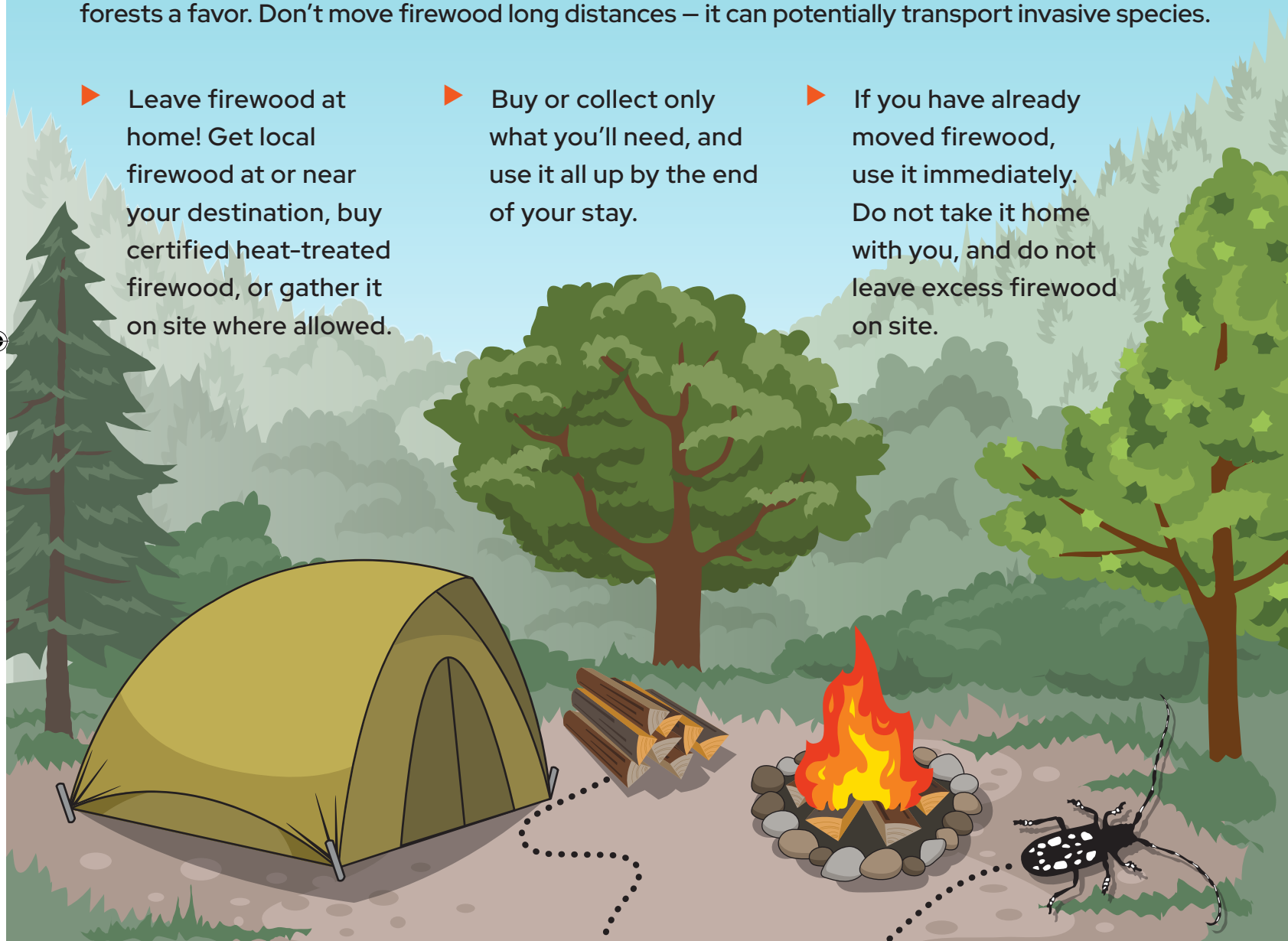


Moving Firewood Transports Tree-Killing Insects and Diseases

BUY IT WHERE YOU BURN IT.

If you're a camper heading out for a trip, or just getting firewood for your wood stove, do the forests a favor. Don't move firewood long distances – it can potentially transport invasive species.

- ▶ Leave firewood at home! Get local firewood at or near your destination, buy certified heat-treated firewood, or gather it on site where allowed.
- ▶ Buy or collect only what you'll need, and use it all up by the end of your stay.
- ▶ If you have already moved firewood, use it immediately. Do not take it home with you, and do not leave excess firewood on site.
