- Many invasive insects and diseases are only found in particular states or regions.
- Moving firewood long distances can spread tree killing organisms to new areas—multiplying their impact and killing millions more trees.

How you can help:

- Build campfires with locally bought firewood
- Never transport firewood from home
- Burn all firewood completely at each destination
- Tell fellow RV enthusiasts to use local firewood
