HELP STOP THE SPREAD OF INVASIVE PESTS & DISEASES.

Our forests are threatened by invasive tree-killing insects and diseases like the emerald ash borer, gypsy moth, and Asian longhorned beetle. These pests don't move far on their own – but in contaminated firewood, they can travel hundreds of miles in a single day. Once transported to uninfested areas, the bugs can emerge and start a new damaging outbreak.

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- Leave firewood at home buy locally or collect on site when permitted
 Puy or collect only what you'll need, and buy
- Buy or collect only what you'll need, and burn it all completely by the end of your stay
